



Work Safety Alert Struck by an Excavator

1. Date of Accident: September 2013

2. Place of Accident: A tunnel under construction in Yuen Long

3. Summary:

A worker was struck to his death by an excavator during mechanical scaling of the wall surface of the tunnel.

4. Work Safety Alert for Contractors/Employers:

To prevent workers from being struck or trapped by mobile plant, contractors/employers undertaking tunneling works should:

- appoint a competent person to conduct risk assessments with due regard to the mobile plant operation, the site layout and work environment;
- formulate and implement an effective safety management system which should include the following:
 - > segregating workers from the operating zone of mobile plant by suitable barriers:
 - ➤ maintaining an unobstructed passageway of not less 600 mm wide between any part of the mobile plant and the tunnel surface;
 - exercising strict access control measures with suitable warning notices in place to avoid unauthorised man-entry into the operating zone of mobile plant;
 - eliminating reversing where possible, by adopting one way traffic system;





- stationing a signaler to give effective signals to plant operators who do not have a clear and unrestricted view of its vicinity;
- installing suitable safety devices on the mobile plant, such as closed-circuit televisions to enhance the operator's views especially at the rear and audio/visual alarms for reversing motion to alert persons working nearby; and
- ensuring that every worker in the working area is wearing a high visibility or reflective vest;
- provide workers with adequate information, training and instruction in respect of the safe system of work for operating mobile plant and traffic management measures; and
- implement effective monitoring and supervision to ensure that the above safety measures are strictly followed.
